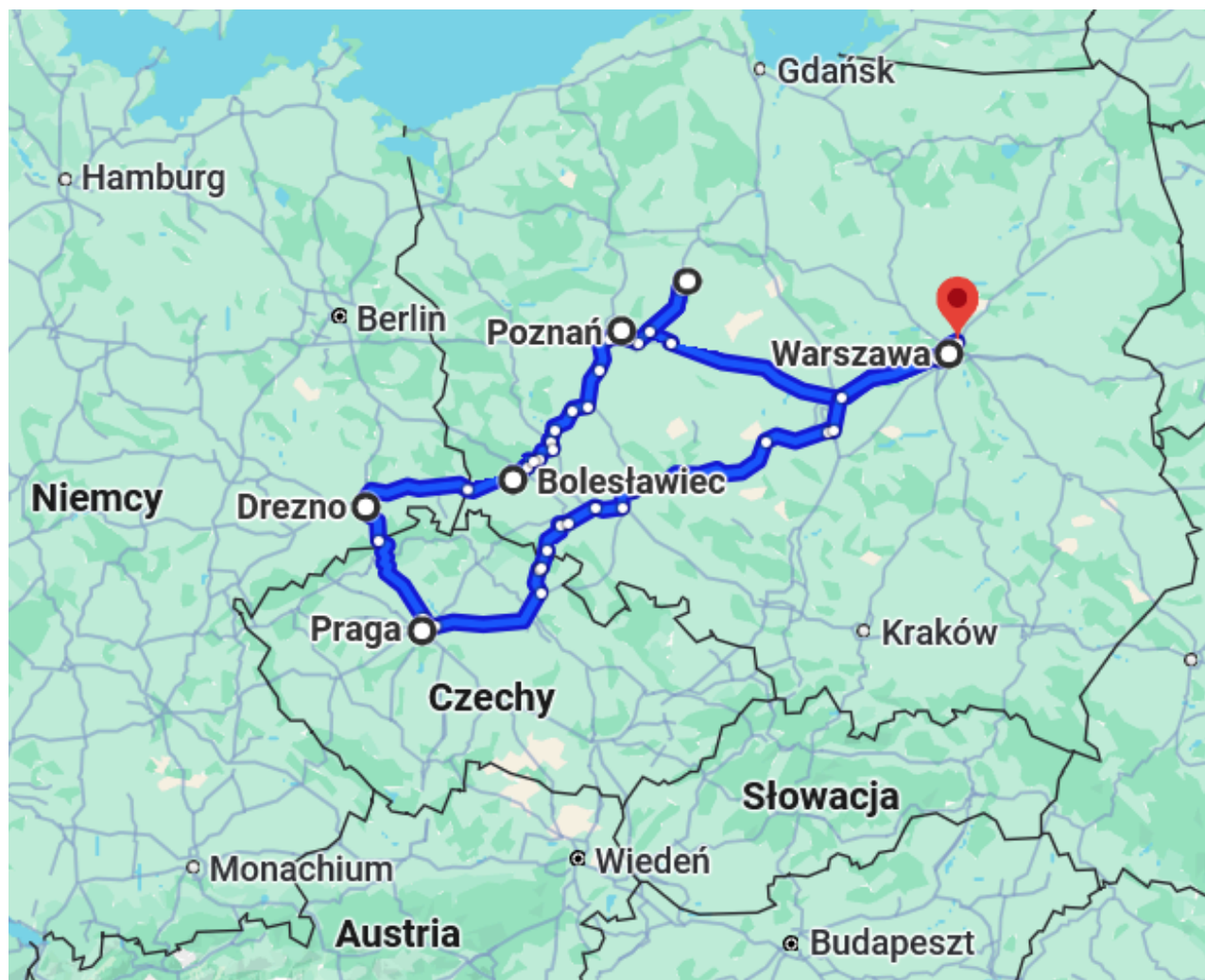

**DAY 0 September 29th, 2025**

Flight to Poland.

In the evening, we will gather for a warm welcome dinner, where you will be treated to a delightful selection of traditional Polish dishes.

**Overnight: Warsaw**

**DAY 2 October 1st, 2025**

Start your day by wandering through Warsaw's historic Old Town, a UNESCO World Heritage. Visit iconic landmarks like the Royal Castle and St. John's Cathedral. Afterward, enjoy a delicious traditional Polish lunch at one of the cozy restaurants in the Old Town, where you can try local specialties like pierogi or bigos. Next, embark on a comfortable bus journey to Poznan, a vibrant city known for its medieval architecture and rich cultural heritage. The drive will take about three hours. After check-in at the hotel, you will have a free evening.

**Overnight: Poznan**

**DAY 3 October 2nd, 2025**

Begin your day by discovering the historic city of Poznan, one of Poland's oldest and most culturally significant cities. Next, enjoy a delightful lunch in one of Poznan's local eateries, where you can savor Polish delicacies. Try some of the regional specialties like kielbasa (sausage), pyzy (dumplings), or zupa ogórkowa (pickle soup), accompanied by a cold drink. After lunch, enjoy some free time to explore Poznan at your own pace.

**DAY 4 October 3rd, 2025**

In the morning visit Biskupin, an archaeological site that showcases an ancient settlement dating back to the early Iron Age. This reconstructed prehistoric village offers a fascinating glimpse into Poland's past. After exploring Biskupin, head to Gniezno for lunch. Next, take a short journey to Gniezno Cathedral, a stunning Gothic structure that once served as the seat of Poland's first archbishops. Explore the cathedral's intricate architecture, the royal tombs, and its historical significance as the place where Poland's first kings were crowned. Return to Poznan for a free late afternoon

**Overnight: Poznan****DAY 5 October 4rd, 2025**

After checking out from hotel head to Rogalin Palace. This 18th-century Baroque residence, once belonging to the noble Raczyński family, boasts stunning architecture, elegant interiors, and beautifully landscaped gardens. After lunch continue your journey to Bolesławiec, a town world-renowned for its traditional Polish pottery. Here, you will participate in a pottery workshop.

**Overnight: Boleslawiec****DAY 6 October 5rd, 2025**

Begin your day with a scenic drive to Dresden, Germany, a city known for its Baroque architecture and rich cultural heritage. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant in Dresden's Old Town, where you can savor German specialties such as , Bratwurst, or traditional Saxon desserts like Eierschecke (layered cake). After lunch, board the bus and continue your journey to Prague, the enchanting capital of the Czech Republic.

**Overnight: Prague****DAY 7 October 6rd, 2025**

Start your exploration in the historic Old Town (Staré Město). you will admire Astronomical Clock one of the oldest working clocks of its kind. Walk across the iconic Charles and continue to the Royal Caste (Hradczany). Enjoy lunch at a traditional Czech restaurant, where you can try local delicacies such as svičková (marinated beef with creamy sauce), goulash, or trdelník (a sweet pastry). After lunch, enjoy some free time.

Start your day by immersing yourself in the unique atmosphere of Wrocław's Old Town. Visit Ostrów Tumski, the oldest part of the city, with its stunning Wrocław Cathedral. Do not forget to search for Wrocław's famous dwarfs—whimsical bronze statues scattered throughout the city, each with a unique story. In the afternoon, enjoy some leisure time to explore Wrocław on your own.

End the day with a farewell dinner, celebrating the wonderful experiences of your journey.
