


MAP OF THE TRIP

DAY 0 September 12th, 2026, Saturday

Flight to Poland.

Start your journey at New York JFK airport. Tour includes flights operated by a Polish Airlines LOT.

DAY 1 September 13th, 2026, Sunday

Arrive in Warsaw, Poland's dynamic capital blending royal heritage with modern European elegance. After hotel check-in and time to rest, enjoy an atmospheric evening walk through the UNESCO-listed Old Town, beautifully reconstructed after World War II. Wander along cobbled streets, and learn about the city's resilient spirit. The day concludes with a welcome dinner where traditional Polish cuisine sets the tone for the journey ahead.

Overnight: Warsaw

DAY 2 September 14th, 2026, Monday

Begin the morning with more exploring Warsaw's historic Old Town. Continue to a boutique, family-run winery set in a peaceful countryside landscape outside of Warsaw. Enjoy a guided visit and tasting of regional wines, The relaxed vineyard atmosphere offers a refreshing contrast to city life. In the late afternoon, return to Warsaw and enjoy an evening at leisure, perfect for dining independently or relaxing at the hotel.

DAY 3 September 15th, 2026, Tuesday

Depart Warsaw toward Poland's northeast, arriving in Augustów, the gateway to the country's lake district. Enjoy a relaxing stop in the unspoiled Rospuda Valley, known for its wetlands, forests, and tranquil beauty, followed by lunch. In the afternoon, cross the border into Lithuania and continue to Vilnius. Upon arrival in this romantic Baltic capital, enjoy free time to stroll through the historic center or relax in a café.

DAY 4 September 16th, 2026, Wednesday

Discover Vilnius. Highlights include Cathedral Square, Gediminas Tower, Pilies Street, and hidden courtyards rich in history and legend. Learn about the city's multicultural past shaped by Lithuanian, Polish, and Jewish heritage. The afternoon is free to explore the bohemian Republic of Užupis, browse art galleries, or enjoy coffee in cozy cafés. A perfect balance of guided discovery and personal exploration.

Overnight: Vilnius

BIAŁOWIEŻA

DAY 5 September 17th, 2026, Thursday

Return to Poland and journey deep into the legendary Białowieża Forest, one of Europe's last remaining primeval woodlands and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This ancient forest is home to the European bison, or żubr, Poland's national animal. With some luck, you may spot these impressive creatures in their natural habitat. The peaceful surroundings offer a unique connection to nature. Enjoy dinner and a quiet evening surrounded by forest landscapes.

LUBLIN

DAY 6 September 18th, 2026, Friday

Begin the day with a guided walk through Białowieża National Park, learning about its unique ecosystem and centuries-old trees. Visit the park museum to better understand the forest's global significance. After lunch, travel south to Lublin, a historic city once standing at the crossroads of cultures and trade routes. Upon arrival, enjoy a relaxed evening at leisure, soaking in the atmosphere of a city known for poetry, legends, and a beautifully preserved Old Town.

OPEN AIR MUSEUM

DAY 7 September 19th, 2026, Saturday

Explore Lublin's charming Old Town. Visit a delightful open-air folk museum, where traditional wooden architecture and regional customs bring Poland's rural past vividly to life. After lunch, travel south toward Rzeszów, a vibrant yet lesser-known city in southeastern Poland. Arrive in the late afternoon and enjoy time to relax or take an evening stroll through the compact city center.

FOLK DANCE SHOW

DAY 8 September 20th, 2026, Sunday

Discover Rzeszów through a guided city tour, learning about its historical roots and modern development. The highlight of the day is a visit to the Ulma Family Museum, a deeply moving place honoring Polish families who risked their lives to save Jews during World War II. Travel to Krakow in the afternoon, with the evening free time for rest or independent exploration.

Overnight: Krakow**DAY 9 September 21st, 2026, Monday**

Spend the day discovering Kraków's Old Town and Wawel Hill, where Polish kings were crowned and buried. Walk through the Main Market Square, admire St. Mary's Basilica, and explore the royal castle overlooking the Vistula River. The afternoon is free for shopping, museums, or relaxation.

Overnight: Krakow**DAY 10 September 22nd, 2026, Tuesday**

Enjoy a full-day excursion to Zakopane, the heart of the Tatra Mountains. Travel through scenic highland landscapes to visit Morskie Oko, Poland's most famous alpine lake, surrounded by dramatic peaks. In Zakopane, browse traditional highlander markets and taste smoked oscypek cheese. Learn about local folklore and mountain culture. Return to Krakow early in the evening.

Overnight: Kraków**DAY 11 September 23rd, 2026, Wednesday**

Late in the morning, we invite you to visit Pieskowa Skała Castle near Kraków, or you may choose to enjoy a free day exploring Kraków on your own. In the evening, we will gather for a farewell dinner with a folk dance show, celebrating our shared experiences and memories.

DAY 12 September 24th, 2026, Thursday
