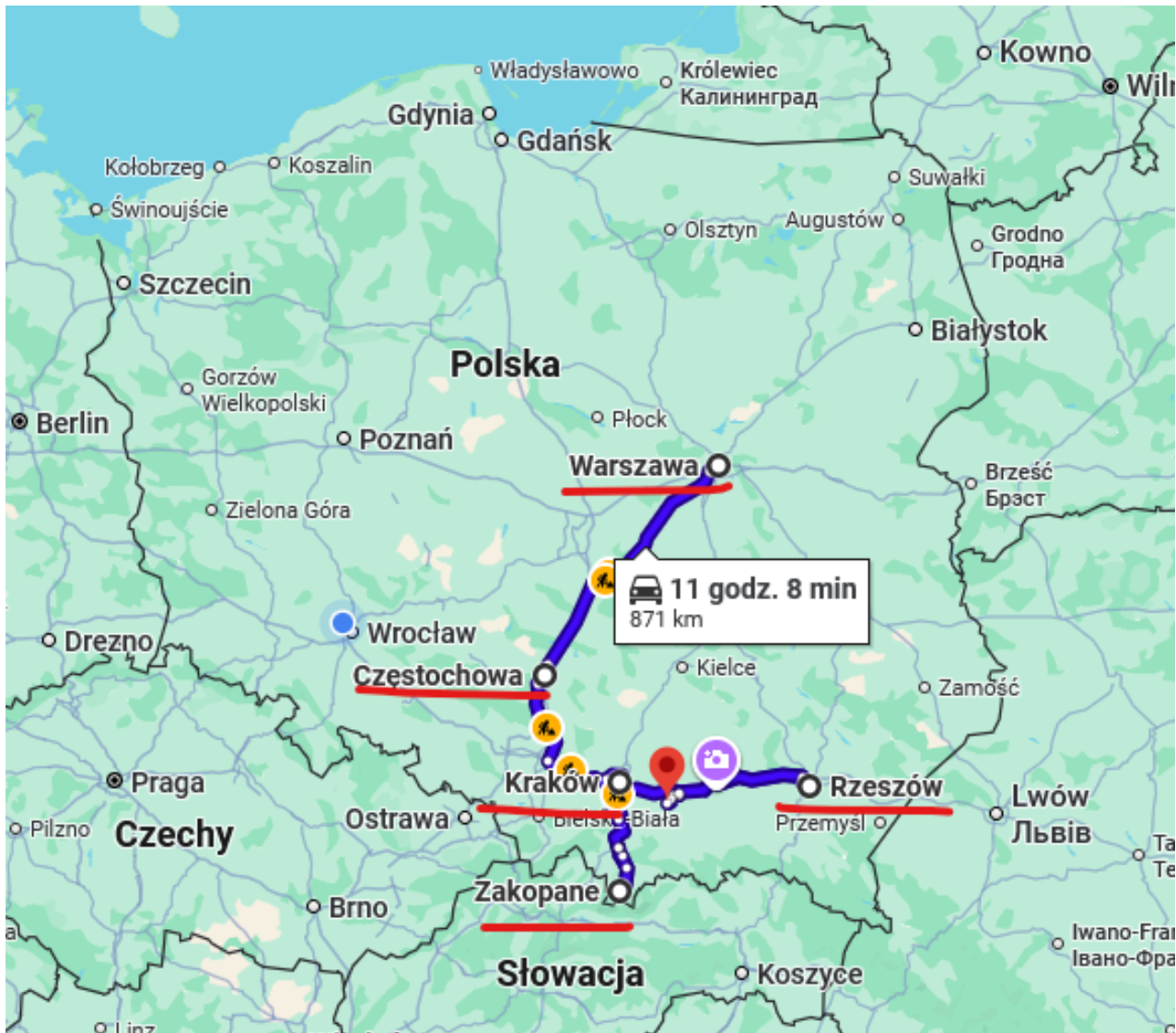


MAP OF THE TRIP

DAY 0 June 20th, 2026. Saturday

Flight to Poland.

DAY 1 June 21st, 2026. Sunday

Overnight: Warsaw

DAY 2 June 22nd, 2026. Monday

Morning Polish language class introducing basic everyday phrases through games, movement, and interactive activities designed especially for young people. Guided sightseeing of Warsaw, including the Royal Castle, where Poland's royal history comes alive, and the Museum of Technology, offering a hands-on and engaging introduction to Polish inventions, engineering, and everyday life in the past.

Visit to the IPN Archive, providing insight into Poland's 20th-century history and historical documentation.

Afterwards, travel south toward Kraków with a stop in Częstochowa, home to one of Poland's most important pilgrimage sites. Just outside the city, lunch at an activity and nature park where you can learn about Polish wildlife, explore outdoor educational paths, and enjoy space to play and relax

DAY 4 June 24th, 2026. Wednesday

Morning Polish language class, building on previously learned phrases and expanding vocabulary in a natural, practical way. Explore historic Kraków, starting with Wawel Hill and Wawel Castle, discovering the story of Polish kings and the legendary Wawel Dragon. Continue with a visit to the Underground Museum beneath the Main Market Square, where medieval Kraków is revealed through interactive exhibits and archaeological remains.

Visit to Oświęcim, with an age-appropriate and sensitively presented introduction to the history and significance of this place. Later in the day, free time.

DAY 10 June 30th, 2026. Tuesday

Horse-drawn carriage ride to the famous Morskie Oko Lake, followed by a leisurely walk back down (approx. 2 hours), allowing time to enjoy the views of the High Tatras.

Visit an authentic highlander (Góral) settlement to learn about local traditions and see how traditional oscypek cheese is made, with opportunities to taste regional products.

Drive back toward Kraków, starting with an exciting stop at Tank Arena, offering hands-on, military-themed activities and interactive experiences. Optional stop at Nowy Wiśnicz Castle to explore its impressive interiors and hear stories linked to Polish history and traditional cuisine, including the cultural background of classic rosół (chicken soup). In the evening farewell dinner.
